

Let's talk about battery life!

I have to change it HOW often?

There are many factors that affect battery life. Size, how often they're used, environment, and features found in the hearing aid all contribute to how long the battery will last.

SIZE - Today's hearing aids now come in small packages. However, it is also important to consider that the smaller the hearing aid battery, the shorter the life of the battery. Also, if more volume is needed the life of the battery will be shorter.

HOW OFTEN THEY'RE USED – The more the hearing aids are used the more drain there will be on the battery. Don't let this discourage you from wearing your hearing aids – the folks that wear their hearing aids more often are generally more satisfied with them! Also, once you've peeled the sticker or tab off the battery, you've activated it so you might as well use it.

ENVIRONMENT – The weather/ environment plays a role as well. Humidity and temperature can cause variance in battery consumption.

PREMIUM FEATURES – Today's hearing aids are advanced and offer features that we could only imagine a few years ago. Wireless function and Bluetooth, as well as multichannel processing can increase battery consumption up to 300 percent.

Remember that hearing aid batteries are toxic when swallowed, so keep them out of reach of children and pets. Store the batteries at room temperature, open the battery door at night to avoid moisture buildup, and keep the tabs on hearing aid batteries until you are ready to use them. Battery manufacturers are now recommending that after taking the tabs off, you wait at least two minutes so the battery has time to absorb enough air to charge it.
